





## Restricted Contractor's Licencing Requirements

1. **ALL PERSONS DOING ELECTRICAL WORK FOR THE COMPANY WORKING IN SASKATCHEWAN ARE REQUIRED TO HOLD A SASKATCHEWAN RESTRICTED JOURNEYMAN LICENCE ISSUED FROM THE DEPARTMENT.**

*A restricted journeyman licence is only valid while the journeyman is employed with the contractor at the time that he applied for the journeyman's licence, the contractor must enclose a letter of recommendation requesting that the person be licenced for his company.*

2. The applicant for the contractor's licence must furnish a guarantee bond in the penal sum of \$5,000 to Ministry of Corrections, Public Safety and Policing. (Such a bond is available from any Insurance Company licenced in Saskatchewan).
3. If the applicant is using a trading/business name, this name must appear on the contractor's bond. e.g. Tim Tully O/A Tim's Electric OR Tim's Electric O/B Tim Tully.)
4. The Corporation Branch, of the Ministry of Justice and Attorney General, requires that all trading/business names be registered in Saskatchewan.
5. The **ORIGINAL BOND ISSUED** must be submitted with the application form for the contractor's licence when applying for a licence and signed by at least one person on behalf of the company. A PHOTOCOPY is not acceptable.
